New MexicoView (NMView) is pleased to offer two \$250 training allowances to a graduate or undergraduate student at any New Mexico University or College. The mission of NMView was founded on the concept of free and public exchange of data, information and knowledge concerning the Earth and its processes, as observed by remote sensing and GIS technologies, for education, research, and local government applications. NMView is a member of AmericaView. AmericaView (AV) is a nationwide partnership of remote sensing scientists who support applied remote sensing research, K-12 and higher STEM education, workforce development, and technology transfer.

The NMView training allowance is available to current graduate or undergraduate students in any department at any New Mexico college or university.

NMView requirements for consideration for this training allowance are:

1. Name, address, telephone number and email address.
2. A 3.0 undergraduate or graduate GPA (must provide a transcript)
3. Write a 500-750 word narrative explaining why you should receive this training allowance, to include but not limited to:
 - A. A description of your research.
 - B. How your research is related to remote sensing or geospatial technologies (Landsat Imagery, GIS, imagery analysis, spatial modeling, etc.)?
 - C. How will you use the training allowance and how will assist you in your effort?
 - D. A map that presents aspects of your work.
